Dear Parents,

Welcome to St. Paul Lutheran School. This is to inform you about our reading curriculum.

It is the teachers' belief that good readers improve through practice. All soccer players, tennis players, golfers, piano players, etc. improve with practice. Besides the regular reading lesson, children are encouraged to read 30-45 minutes per day in lower grades and 60 minutes a day beginning in 4th grade.

Whenever a student finishes an assignment, he/she has a library book with him/her to be reading. When completed, the student takes a computerized test. Points are given for correct answers and each grade level with student/teacher conferencing assigns points with each student for the quarter. This reading is a percentage of the grade for that quarter.

To access St. Paul's library of suggested books which your child can begin to read now, please use www.cyberfalcon.com/library. Reading grade level and number of points are shown in the information given for each book.

The sooner your student begins to get in the habit of daily reading, going to the library regularly, becoming fascinated with the world of books, the easier his/her adjustment to St. Paul's curriculum becomes.
